## Clothes

Pack suitable clothing for the time of year and type of outing.

☐ shoes good for hiking  
☐ socks for each day  
☐ underwear for each day

☐ extra pants  
☐ t-shirt for each day  
☐ sweatshirt or jacket  
☐ raincoat/poncho

## Personal Items

☐ CUP, BOWL & KNIFE/FORK/SPOON  
☐ pack or duffel bag to pack in  
☐ camp chair

☐ comb/brush

☐ notebook and pencils/pens  
☐ water bottle  
☐ spending money (can be held by adult)  
☐ insect repellent  
☐ sun screen

## Bedding

☐ sleeping bag in stuff sack or tied snugly  
☐ air mattress or ground pad tied snugly  
☐ small pillow or pillow case (stuff clothes in it and it makes a great pillow)
